1 Oct 1966: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS, enclosure (2).

2 Oct 1966: Four CH-46A from HMM-265 lifted 603 Marines of Cassandra 2/5 from Dong Ha to YD081604 on strike in support of Operation Prairie.

3 Oct 1966: Five aircraft from HMM-265 lifted 817 ARVN from Dong Ha to YD215665 on Operation Prairie.

4 Oct 1966-5 Oct 1966: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS. In addition HMM-265 flew three launches with the HIS (Helicopter Illumination System) on 4 Oct 1966.

6 Oct 1966: Two pilots and two crewmen in aircraft EF-154 missing in action enroute Phu Bai to Marble Mountain Air Facility. Subsequent SAR conducted with negative results.

7 Oct 1966-11 Oct 1966: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

12 Oct 1966: Five CH-46A from HMM-265 accompanied by five HMM-164 aircraft

carried 650 Marines from Dong Ha to YD081656 on strike in support of Operation Prairie.

13 Oct 1966: Four aircraft from HMM-265 participated in VIP lift at Dong Ha during the Secretary of Defense, the Honorable Robert S. McNAMARA's, visit.

14 Oct 1966-15 Oct 1966: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

16 Oct 1966: Two CH-46A from HMM-265 departed for Khe Sanh to work in conjunction with Army Special Forces. The squadron has obtained the commitment for 30 days.

17 Oct 1966-23 Oct 1966: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

24 Oct 1966: Three aircraft from HMM-265 accompanied three HMM-164 aircraft on strike. Carried 203 Marines from LZ Crawdad to AT875392 receiving small arms fire from both zones. Three CH-46A carried 173 Marines on strike from Phu Bai to YD791056.

25 Oct 1966: Four CH-46A from HMM-265 carried 210 Marines on strike from LZ Crawdad to AT875392. Aircraft receiving fire going into LZ taking five hits: six aircraft from HMM-265 carried 440 Marines on four retractions. Carried troops from AT877394 to BT015625, from AT858403 to An Hoa, from AT864387 to Dai Loc and from An Hoa to Hill 55.
