Part II Narrative Summary:

1 Feb 1967: LtCol. C. D. CORN assumed command of Marine Medium Helicopter Squadron 265 from Major F. B. ELLIS.

Major E. W. GILBERT led a flight of eight BONNIE SUE aircraft in support of Operation Independence. The flight flew a total of eighty-four sorties and carried four hundred and ninety-nine troops into landing zone DOVE (AT802465).

2 Feb 1967: Major R. O. HARPER led four BONNIE SUE aircraft on a "feint landing" in support of mission 7005 operating out of Dong Ha.

3 Feb 1967: Major D. E. WEBB led a flight of two BONNIE SUE aircraft on an emergency retraction of a 12 man recon team (BULLRUSH) located at AT830648. During the retraction the number two aircraft (EP-160, piloted by 1stLt. G. R. JEFFERSON) crashed in the zone due to striking a large boulder with the aft rotor blades. The boulder was hidden from view by tall elephant grass. The aircraft sustained BRAVO damage. Immediately thereafter, Capt. G. W. CUMPSTON led four BONNIE SUE aircraft to insert a 48 man reaction team necessary to secure the area around EP-160 during the evening.

4 Feb 1967: Major C. H. PITMAN led six BONNIE SUE aircraft in the recovery of the BULLRUSH reaction force. EP-160 was recovered by an Army CH-54 and returned to Marble Mountain.

5-7 Feb 1967: Normal operations, see SITREPS.

8 Feb 1967: Major D. E. WEBB led a flight of two BONNIE SUE aircraft on an emergency extraction of recon team MORBID II (XD666614). Captain G. L. YOUNG made a insertion of recon team TOUGHDOWN (XD666614) from Khe Sahn and then executed an emergency retraction of the same team thirty minutes later.

9 Feb 1967: LtCol. C. D. CORN led a flight of three BONNIE SUE aircraft on a resupply mission to Que Son. Small arms fire was received in the vicinity of BTO739. The three aircraft carried a total of 23,650 lbs. of cargo in nine sorties. Major R. F. SMITH led three BONNIE SUE aircraft on an administrative retraction of troops during Operation Independence. A total of 15.8 flight hours were expended transporting 524 troops.

10-11 Feb 1967: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

12 Feb 1967: LtCol. C. D. CORN led six BONNIE SUE aircraft on a "feint landing" to BTO249 in support of Operation Stone.

13-15 Feb 1967: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

16 Feb 1967: Major D. E. WEBB led a flight of four BONNIE SUE aircraft on mission #2001; 314 troops were inserted in support of Operation Prairie. Captain R. H. LANGENFELD, accompanied by 1st Lt. B. A. MAJOR as his wingman, inserted and retracted four recon teams totaling 95 troops.

17-18 Feb 1967: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

19 Feb 1967: Capt. T. C. MCALLISTER flew an emergency extraction of recon team PARTY LINE II from YD479256. Capt. B. W. ROLFE led a four plane SPARROW HAWK mission to YD925145 to insert a 54 man reaction force.

20 Feb 1967: Major C. R. PITMAN led a flight of two BONNIE SUE aircraft on an emergency Medevac mission to AT954644. Aircraft received enemy fire entering and departing the zone. No hits were received.

21 Feb 1967: LtCol. C. D. CORN led an insertion, including a "feint landing" of 35 ARVN and 3 Special Forces personnel, into YD302083. Two BONNIE SUE aircraft were assigned to a SOG insertion. (Top Secret).

22 Feb 1967: Captain H. H. CLARK led two BONNIE SUE aircraft on three recon insertions and extractions.

23 Feb 1967: Major R. O. HARPER led three BONNIE SUE and one NORTHBROOK aircraft on a night emergency troop lift of 154 ARVN troops from Hue Citadel to YD960165. Major J. L. DRIEFER led a flight of four BONNIE SUE aircraft on an attempted night emergency retraction of the Special Forces personnel inserted into the A Shau Valley 21 Feb. Major DRIEFER's aircraft

suffered badly damaged rotor blades from striking trees in the landing zone and also received two hits from enemy fire, damaging his utility hydraulic system. Major DRIEFER advised the Special Forces to either move to a more suitable zone or cut down the trees in the present one. The four BONNIE SUE aircraft then returned to Phu Bai for fuel.

At 2100H the same evening Capt. H. H. CLARK led the three remaining aircraft to retract the Special Forces personnel. The Special Forces had enlarged the landing zone but it was still too small for a CH-46. The Special Forces personnel were successfully retracted, but all three aircraft suffered damaged rotor blades from striking the trees in the zone, and two aircraft were hit by enemy fire.

24-27 Feb 1967: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

28 Feb 1967: Major J. L. DRIEFER led two BONNIE SUE aircraft on an emergency extraction at YC891994. The lead aircraft received five hits and Corporal T. M. BASTYR was wounded. Capt. G. R. LEAR led two BONNIE SUE aircraft on an emergency ammo resupply to YD110604 and received fire coming out of the zone. The lead aircraft received four hits and Corporal E. J. PENDERGRASS, Jr. was wounded.

1. Personnel: Joined 23 personnel and transferred 31 during the month of February 1967.

- a. One Staff Sergeant promoted to Gunnery Sergeant.
- b. One Sergeant promoted to Staff Sergeant.

2. Administration:

a. Eight (8) Purple Hearts, one Distinguished Flying Cross and 119 Air Medals were awarded during the month of February 1967

3. Casualties:

a. Corporal E. J. PENDERGRASS, Jr. 2109622/6412, received a bullet in the heel, a minor injury. Injury occurred 8 miles West-Northwest of Dong Ha on mission number 4007.

b. Corporal T. M. BASTYR 2029572/6611, received a superficial shrapnel wound in the buttocks. Returned to duty. Injury occurred 8 miles South of Dong Ha on mission number 28-17A.

4. Civil Action: No civil action during the month of February 1967.
5. Information Services: 131 News Releases went out in February 1967.
6. Intelligence/Counter Intelligence:
 - a. Briefings were given by the Intelligence Section prior to each flight and debriefings were given after the termination of each flight, as applicable.
 - b. The command received a letter from an indigenous person asking for a squadron patch. The letter was forwarded to higher command for action.
7. Air Operations:
 - a. Total hours flown: 871.9
 - b. Number of Sorties: 2,495
 - c. Pounds of Cargo: 900,000
 - d. Number of Medical Evacuations: 203
 - e. Number of passengers carried: 8,220
8. Special Operations:
 - a. This squadron participated in operations Independence, Stone I, Stone II, Prairie II and Chinook II.
9. Ground Defense:
 - a. This squadron had one (1) officer and three (3) enlisted assigned to ZULU Company for the purpose of perimeter guard during the month of February.
10. NBC Warfare:
 - a. No NBC Warfare training was conducted during the month of February.
11. Training:
 - a. HMM-265 sent one officer and four (4) enlisted men to JEST School, Cubi Point, P.I., four enlisted men to Aerial Gunners School at Camp Hansen, Okinawa and one (1) enlisted man to Corrosion Control School, Tachikawa, Japan.

a. An average daily availability of 68.1 percent was maintained with an average number of 20 aircraft possessed. Aircraft down due to NORS averaged 16.5 percent; aircraft down due to NORM averaged 15.4 percent.
