Part II Narrative Summary:

1 March 1967: Major R. O. HARPER led a three plane emergency MedEvac at midnight. LIMA Company 3d Bn 3d Marines had made heavy contact with enemy units moving south out of the DMZ; their position had received intensive mortar attacks. The flight attempted for over an hour to get into the zone. Restricted by darkness, weather and enemy situation, the aircraft were unable to land and returned to Dong Ha. At first light the aircraft returned to position and evacuated forty-seven Marines.

2 March 1967: Major C. H. PITMAN's section of two aircraft carried seventy-three MedEvacs to Khe Sahn from an area several miles southwest.

3 March 1967: Early this morning, the airfield at Khe Sanh was attacked by an enemy force estimated as company size. During the ensuing mortar attack, the two HMM-265 aircraft in Major PITMAN's section received heavy damage. One aircraft, BuNo 152498, sustained major damage as a result of a direct hit slightly aft of the forward pylon. The other aircraft BuNo 152525 received approximately 500 shrapnel holes. No squadron personnel were injured.

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4-5 March 1967: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

6 March 1967: Major R. F. SMITH led a section of two aircraft in marginal weather for an emergency MedEvac/resupply mission for 1st Bn 9th Marines. This zone, located ten miles west of Dong Ha, was extremely limited because of the poor visibility and high trees. Enemy small arms fire was received in the zone during the successful completion of the mission.

7-10 March 1967: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

11 March 1967: Captain H. R. MILLS and his wingman 1stLt. M. J. PEPPIE proceeded to an ARVN outpost eight miles north of Dong Ha for an emergency MedEvac at 2230. Despite darkness and poor weather conditions and enemy small arms fire in the area of the landing zone, the mission was successfully completed. Captain H. R. MILLS and 1stLt. M. J. PEPPIE later returned to the landing zone with emergency resupplies.

12-14 March 1967: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

15 March 1967: With less than one hour of notification, a flight of six aircraft led by LtCol. C. D. CORN were launched at 0430 for an emergency troop lift in response to a rocket attack on Danang airfield complex. A blocking force consisting of over one hundred U. S. troops were inserted under flares into the landing zone about seven miles southwest of Danang within two hours after receipt of the initial mission. The lift was completed successfully by 0630.

16 March 1967: Late in the afternoon, Captain B. W. ROLFE and his wingman, Major T. S. DUNLAP reacted to an emergency troop lift. A Marine platoon had contacted an enemy force just three miles northwest of Khe Sanh. Two HMM-164 aircraft had previously inserted one reaction force into the position, resulting in one of the aircraft being downed by enemy fire near the drop zone. Captain ROLFE's section inserted a forty-seven man reaction force to reinforce the beleaguered unit. After the first insertion, Captain ROLFE retracted the downed HMM-164 aircraft's crew. Maximum control was required to carry these loads under the restrictive altitude and temperature conditions while taking enemy fire. Captain ROLFE's section returned to the zone during darkness several hours later. Once again enemy fire harassed the pilots as they completed their mission of extracting four loads of MedEvacs.

17-22 March 1967: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

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ENCLOSURE (1)

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23 March 1967: Reacting to an emergency resupply and MedEvac mission at 1700, Captain H. R. MILLS, led a two plane section to a zone eleven miles west of Dong Ha. During the accomplishment of the mission, both aircraft received numerous hits from heavy automatic weapons fire originating from enemy positions west of the zone.

Upon completion of an emergency mission (drone recovery), Captain H. H. CLARK led a section to An Hoa for an emergency resupply of the 2d Bn 5th Marines 17 miles southwest of Danang. Enemy fire was received from several automatic weapons positions two miles north of An Hoa.

24 March 1967: Flying number two on a HMM-163 aircraft, Captain P. M. NICK launched on a night emergency resupply mission in marginal weather. Heavy enemy fire was received several miles east of the 3d Bn 3d Marines position. Captain NICK's aircraft received one hit but assisted in successfully accomplishing three separate emergency missions in the area ten miles west of Dong Ha.

25 March 1967: Captain R. W. ROLFE led a nine plane strike into an area eighteen miles south of Danang. Two companies were inserted in three waves. Enemy fire was received on each approach and departure but was effectively suppressed by the UH-1E gunships and fixed wing escort aircraft controlled by the MAG-16 TAC(A).

26 March 1967: Aborting his approach in the insertion of the 3d Recon Bn Recon team, Major T. S. DUNIAP's aircraft received heavy automatic weapons fire from the chosen zone. Fire was returned by the aircraft's gunners and recon personnel aboard.

27-31 March 1967: Normal operations, see daily SITREPS.

c. Captain H. R. MILLS 082941/7335 USMC, received shrapnel in the calf of the right leg, minor injury, returned to duty. Injury occurred at YD162721 on 23 March 1967.

d. Staff Sergeant C. H. DICKEY 1492818/6320 USMC, received shrapnel in the right forearm; minor injury; returned to duty. Injury occurred 23 March 1967 at YD 764203 southeast of the DMZ.
