Part II: Narrative Summary

1 August 1966 - 5 August 1966

Normal operations: See daily SITREPS, enclosure (2).

6 August 1966

Ten CH-46A helicopters from HMM-265 lifted 620 troops in support of operation "Colorado". Three aircraft were hit and many anti-helo stakes were encountered in the landing zone.

7 August 1966

Normal operations: See daily SITREPS, enclosure (2).

8 August 1966

Two helicopters were hit while attempting to reinforce a platoon of Marines west of Dong Ha. A total of three pilots and four crew members were wounded. One pilot and two crew members were evacuated to more sophisticated medical facilities.

9 August 1966 - 13 August 1966

Normal operations: See daily SITREPS, enclosure (2).

14 August 1966

Two helicopters were launched on a "Sparrowhawk" mission. The mission was an emergency extraction of ten U. S. Marines. One man was wounded and taken to "Charlie Med" facility.

15 August 1966 - 31 August 1966


