3. Summary of Significant Events

a. Personnel. One Staff Sergeant promoted to Gunnery Sergeant.

b. Maintenance

(1) Two aircraft received extensive combat damage. One was repaired locally. The other was sent to the Progressive Aircraft Repair Facility at NAS Atsugi, Japan.

(2) The maintenance department has begun painting the aircraft with VMFA-542 markings.

c. Air Operations. The squadron flew 603 sorties for 860.6 hours.

sorties were flown in support of Operation Double Eagle. The squadron continued to fly Interdiction/Blue Blazer and special missions as well as the Firecracker Combat Air Patrols and escorts in support of VMCI-1 and the C-130 tankers.

d. Ordnance. During the month of February, the squadron expended 2745 bombs and 224 napalm bombs for a total of 592 tons of bombs. 1434 2.75" rockets were also expended.
