NARRATIVE SUMMARY

1 Jan: Cardinal SPELLMAN was transported by HMM-361 to Camp Hansen where he held a New Year's Mass.

2 Jan: Cardinal SPELLMAN was taken to the Naha terminal by a Tarbush aircraft for his departure to the United States.

3 Jan: General KRULAK visited several Marine bases in the HMM-361 "White-back".

4 Jan: Captains F. P. KOLBE and J. J. CLASBY and Cpls LEHNIS and O'BRIEN were presented medals by General KRULAK when he visited the squadron. The General was briefed on HMM-361's operations in Viet Nam by LtCol TWEED

6 Jan: Sixty (60) Marines participated in a paratroop from two (2) HMM-361 aircraft at Camp Hansen.

11 Jan: The Commandant of the Marine Corps was briefed on HMM-361's operations by LtCol TWEED. General GREENE was then transported by HMM-361 to Kadena for his departure to the United States.

13 Jan: B GENERAL METZGER and party were taken to Bolo Point to watch an Army demonstration of the Hawk missile.

Two (2) Tarbush aircraft went to the island of Okino-Erabu-Shima where they picked up a civilian, who was bleeding internally, and rushed him to Naha.

19 Jan: Mr. Hideo HORO, Deputy Director General, Prime Minister Office, Government of Japan, and party were transported by Tarbush aircraft to Nago Stadium from Hamby airfield.

Two (2) Tarbush UH-34's picked up thirteen (13) Marines at LZ 13. The Marines had been injured by an overturned truck and were rushed to the Kue Army Hospital.

20 Jan: At 0100I two (2) Tarbush helicopters launched on an emergency medevac of a civilian on the island of Kume-Shima, who was bleeding internally. The medevac was taken to Naha and an awaiting ambulance.

22 Jan: B General VAN STOCKUM was transported by HMM-361 from Camp Courtney to Navy Operations at Naha.

Two (2) Tarbush UH-34's picked up an Army soldier, who had broken both legs, and rushed him to the Kue Army Hospital from Toko Shiki.

23 Jan: A party of six (6) were picked up at the Naha Port Terminal and taken to the dedication of a sugar plant.

27 Jan: A female civilian with extreme intestinal pain was evacuated from Izina-Shima by two Tarbush aircraft and was taken to Naha AFB.
