PART II
NARRATIVE SUMMARY

During the reporting period 1 October thru 31 October 1968, HMM-362 operating from Marble Mountain Air Facility, was under the operational control of Marine Aircraft Group 16. The primary missions assigned HMM-362 during this period were day and night medevac, VIP chase, administrative tasks and SAR at Chu Lai. Operations supported during this period were Victory Dragon, Maui Peak, and Henderson Hill. Victory Dragon was under the control of the Republic of Korea Marine Corps and Maui Peak was a combined operation of second and third Battalions of the ARVN's 51st Regiment. Henderson Hill was in support of the Fifth Marines.

During the reporting period HMM-362 lost two aircraft. The loss of the first aircraft was due to direct enemy action while trying to make a hoist pick-up of an emergency medevac. No one was injured in the crash. The loss of the second aircraft was due to a mid-air collision over a landing zone. This accident occurred during marginal weather conditions and in a high density area over a landing zone. All persons aboard both aircraft were killed. Another aircraft received substantial damage. This aircraft received automatic weapons fire while flying medevacs out of a zone. The aircraft's throttle control was shot away. The aircraft shot a full autorotation into An Hoa. A hard landing was made due to lack of control response and the right main gear broke off. Two crew members were wounded during this incident.

As a result of the loss of the aircraft due to the mid-air collision it has been reemphasized to all pilots and crewmen to be extremely observant of aircraft in the area in which they are working.
