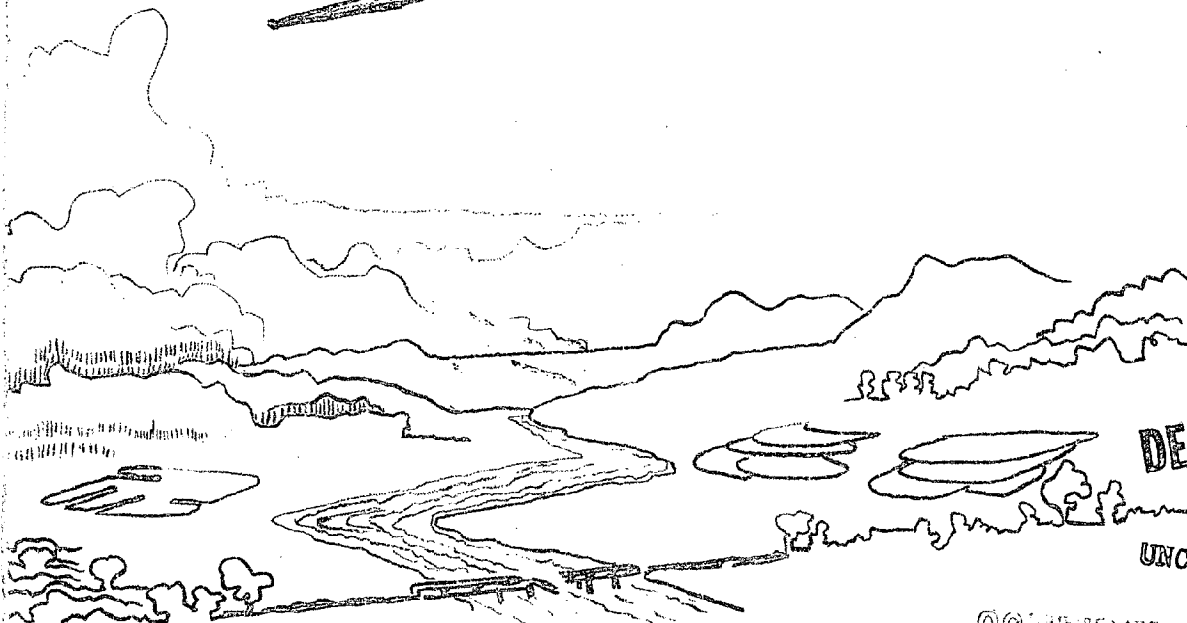
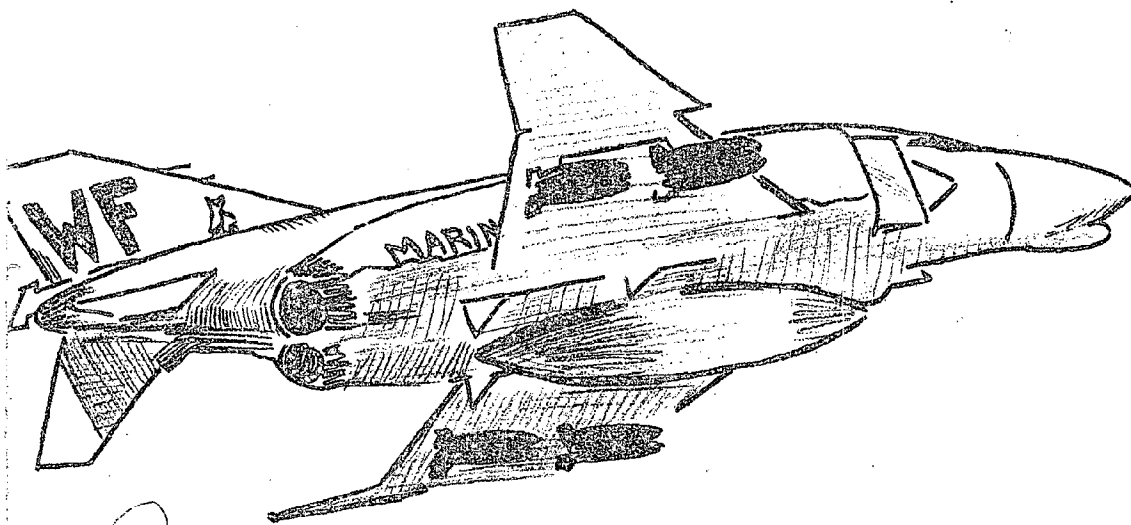

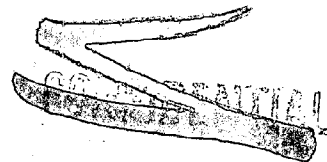

SUMMARY FOR DEPLOYMENT AND RELIEF OF VMFA-531 AT DANANG AB, REPUBLIC OF VIETNAM.

The squadron deployed from NAS, Atsugi, Japan to DaNang AirBase, Republic of Vietnam utilizing the following:

- 30 May 1965: One C-130 Aircraft carrying 24 passengers with 19,765 lbs cargo and baggage.
- 11 June 1965: One C-130 Aircraft carrying 75 passengers with 11,175 lbs of baggage.
- 13 June 1965: Two C-130 Aircraft carrying 79 passengers with 35,200 lbs of cargo and baggage.
- 14 June 1965: One C-130 Aircraft with 10 passengers with 21,410 lbs of cargo and baggage.

Squadron aircraft were transitioned into DaNang Airbase in increments starting on 2 June 1965 and was completed on 14 June 1965. These aircraft replaced aircraft from VMFA-531 who transported their aircraft out as replacements arrived. The transition of replacement aircraft and crews went smoothly with no drop in operational efficiency. The transition was completed on 2400/ 14 June 1965 and the entire operational command was passed to VMFA-513 on that date.

The administrative move was also completed on 15 June 1965 with no lag or drop in efficiency.

SUMMARY FOR 15 - 30 JUNE 1965

1. Marine Fighter/Attack Squadron 513 flew 256 combat sorties on 72 missions. Total number of hours flown was 304 of which all but 3 sorties were combat hops. The average aircraft availability was 12 of 15.
2. The missions/targets assigned were generally undefended and very little defensive fire was encountered. This was all small arms fire with sporadic automatic weapons. No aircraft received any hits from enemy fire. However, slight fragmentation damage to F-4B, BuNo 151462, occurred on 20 June.
3. The squadron maintained aircraft on alert for possible scramble in support of III MAF and I Corps. This alert/standby consisted of two aircraft on 15 minute alert and two on 30 minute standby between 0700-1900. Two aircraft were maintained in a 30 minute standby capability from 1900-0700.
4. Of the 72 missions assigned, 58% were interdiction in support of the I Corps, 25% were interdiction in support of the II Corps, 10% were helicopter escort, 7% MAF scrambles and 4% I Corps scrambles.
5. Total ordnance expended: 261 MK-81 250 lb GP bombs, 104 MK-82 500 lb GP bombs, 86 MK-83 1000 lb bombs, 22 MK-77 500 lb Napalm, 104 MK-79 1000 lb Napalm, 2,472 5" Zuni's and 814 2.75 FFAR's.
6. Damage assessment given by the Forward Air Controllers were given on less than 50% of the missions. Tree coverage, turbulence and ground fire were the predominant causes of incomplete damage assessment. The assessed damages included 223 structures destroyed, 51 structures damaged, 4 secondary explosions, 1 mortar destroyed, 1 machine gun destroyed, 5 gun emplacements destroyed, 22 troops killed by air, 40 troops wounded by air, 1 water buffalo killed, 1 tunnel complex damaged and 1 food storage area damaged. Further reports on damage may follow on later dates and will be included separately for the next reporting period.
7. The total JP-4 consumed for the period was 579,008 gallons. Camp construction, mainly in the form of tent flooring, is continuing as lumber becomes available. Approximately 15 tents were floored during this time period with 6 tents/floors left to be installed. Camp electrical power remains the major problem because of lack of parts, sandy and dusty operating conditions and inexperienced maintenance personnel. Preparations for the arrival of VMFA-542 are being made including erection of all available tentage and construction of additional head facilities.

Major problems are lack of availability of good lumber for camp construction, shortages in water purification unit supplies, and inadequate motor transportation parts support.
