PART II. NARRATIVE SUMMARY.

During the period 1-31 August 1967, VMFA-542 conducted operations in support of the III Marine Amphibious Force and the 7th Air Force. The area of operations ranged from the southern panhandle of North Vietnam, through the DMZ and to the southern boundaries of I Corps. This squadron flew in support of operations Kingfisher, Ardmore, Kangaroo Kick, Cumberland, Rush, Hood River, Chochise, Fremont, Benton and Beacon Gate. The squadron has now flown over 10,643 combat sorties and over 13,340 combat hours in Vietnam. The following crew members surpassed three hundred total combat missions during this month: Captains P.
