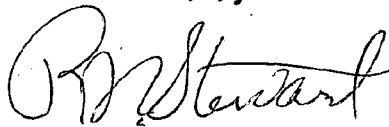

On 18 June Brigadier General William G. JOHNSON, Assistant Wing Commander, First Marine Aircraft Wing, visited the squadron hangar area.

PART II - Narrative Summary of Significant Highlights

On 5 June an F4B flown by Capt. BRYAN and Capt. BURNS, while under the control of FAC(A) "Hostage Golf", in support of the 5th Marines, attacked an enemy bunker complex and accounted for two bunkers destroyed and eight VC/NVA KBMA.

On 9 June an F4B flown by Capt. CROUCH and LT. GRIMM, under the control of a Misty TAC(A), attacked a 23MM gunsite in the Steel Tiger area. Though taking intense ground fire they accounted for three bunkers and the 23MM gun site destroyed.

On 10 June two F4B's flown by Maj. DOLAN, LT. McKENNEY, LT. VADYAK, and Capt. BURNS while working with FAC(A) Bilk 16 in support of the Army's 101st Airborne Division, attacked an enemy bunker complex. They accounted for one bunker destroyed and seven VC/NVA KBMA while taking heavy small arms fire from the ground.

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On 18 June two F4B's flown by Capt. BRYAN, Capt. BURNS, LT. BERNARD, and LT. GOERGEN attacked a fortified village which was under assault by the Army's Americal Division. Under marginal weather conditions and intense .30/.50 CAL automatic weapons ground fire they accounted for four structures, three bunkers, two automatic weapons destroyed and six VC/NVA KBMA.

On 21 June an F4B flown by Maj. HANNA and LT. CONSTANTINE attacked a POL and supply point located on a navigable river in the Steel Tiger area. Working this target under marginal weather conditions they accounted for the destruction of a barge loaded with supply pallets and obtained one large secondary explosion.

On 25 June an F4B flown by LT. VADYAK and LT. TALBOT, while providing close air support to an element of the 3rd Marine Division in Northern I Corps, was shot down by intense small arms and automatic weapons fire, which included numerous .50 caliber gun positions. Both aircrew ejected and during their parachute descents were subjected to heavy but inaccurate enemy small arms and automatic weapons fire. The aircrew landed safely, however, and were rescued within the hour by friendly forces and helicopters. LT. VADYAK received minor injuries, including a badly sprained knee, as a result of his ejection and parachute landing and has been returned to a limited duty status. LT. TALBOT received a broken shoulder during ejection and has been med-evaced to Japan for medical attention and convalescence.

On 28 June two F4B's flown by Maj. BRAUN, LT. DEAN, Capt. SAUER and LT. McKENNEY, while supporting the Army's 101st Airborne Division, attacked an enemy bunker complex. They accounted for eight bunkers, one .50 CAL gun position destroyed and setting sustained fire.

On 28 June two F4B's flown by LTCOL. STEWART, LT. GOERGEN, Maj. BAILEY and Capt. FLANIGAN, while under the control of FAC(A) Seaworthy 97-16, attacked an enemy bunker complex and mortar position. They accounted for three bunkers, three fighting holes, one gun position and one .50 CAL gun destroyed.

On 29 June two F4B's flown by Maj. WEISS, LT. McKENNEY, Capt. ZIMMER, and LT. MARES, while supporting the 3rd Marine Division, attacked an enemy bunker complex. Though working under marginal weather conditions they accounted for two bunkers destroyed and one VC/NVA KBMA.

Overall for the month of June VMFA-542 aircrew accounted for a total of thirty five VC/NVA enemy troops confirmed KBMA while conducting air operations support of Marine Corps, Army and Free World Military and Allied forces.

5. Aviation Safety

a. Ground Accidents - None.

b. Incidents, No Injuries, No Damage

On 5 June F4B 151468 lost its MER due to a malfunction in the AERO-27A bomb ejection rack. No damage, no injuries.

On 19 June F4B 150649 experienced a utility hydraulic failure. No damage, no injuries.

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c. Incidents, No Injuries, Limited Damage

On 10 June F4B 153041 received a tear in its port stabilator when a MK-82 snake-eye bomb fin retaining band struck the stabilator. No injuries, limited damage.

On 23 June F4B 151468 received damage to the port leading edge flap when the port TER failed allowing a LAU-10A to separate from the aircraft. No injuries, limited damage.

d. Minor Accident, No Injuries, Minor Damage

On 11 June F4B 150418 suffered damage to the port wing area when the port LAU-17A explosive bolt failed allowing the entire port store to separate from the aircraft on landing. No injuries, minor damage.

e. Direct Enemy Action Hit Incidents, No Injuries, Limited Damage

On 13 June F4B 152249 received one small arms round in the port wing. No injuries, limited damage.

On 14 June F4B 150639 received one small arms round in the aft section at the starboard engine and one small arms round in the starboard wing tank. No injuries, limited damage.

On 21 June F4B 151514 received one small arms round in the starboard stabilator. No injuries, limited damage.

f. Direct Enemy Action Hit Accident, Major/Minor Injury, Alfa Damage

On 25 June F4B 151416 was lost due to hostile ground fire. Both crewmembers ejected successfully and were recovered by SAR forces. Alfa damage, VADYAK, Andrew 1stLt., 0101549, USMCR, 7521, Pilot, Minor injury. TALBOT, Stephen S. 1stLt., USMCR, 0101531, RIO, Major injury.

6. Logistics

a. The aircraft situation described in the previous report has further deteriorated due to the substantial damage sustained by BuNo 150418, and the loss of BuNo 151416 due to enemy action.

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BuNo 150418 accounted for 19 days of NORM time. The foreseen increase in selective interchange of parts has, in fact, occurred in order to meet present commitments. Eighty-eight items were interchanged as of the 24th of June. The 16.4% NORS rate effectively reduces the squadrons daily availability by two aircraft. Eleven aircraft on hand are projected for the month of July since two aircraft are scheduled for rework. Without the assignment of additional aircraft, the situation can only become more acute. This squadron has a T/O of 15 aircraft. The average number of aircraft in an A-1 status during the month of June was 13.3%. A total of 563 sorties were flown during June, resulting in 603.7 flight hours and a utilization of 129.3%.

c. This squadron's Not Operational Ready Rate for supply exceeds the the NORS Standards for Aircraft specified by the OPNAVINST. 5442.4. This is due to parts presently on order not being on hand in the local supply system. Action taken by this activity consists of sending follow-ups to Group Supply, initiated by our expeditor. Our current status is still awaiting parts and future action consists of more follow-ups.
