PART II

NARRATIVE SUMMARY

The last six months of VMFA-542 was marked by the transition from a highly trained combat squadron to a cadre status consisting of one officer.

January 13 marked the end of 542's combat flying in Vietnam with a night interdiction flight in Laos flown by Lt.Col. Keith Smith and 1stLt Roger Blair. From January 13 to January 31 the squadron devoted its time and efforts preparing for an 8,000 mile TRANSPAC from DaNang to El Toro. On 30 January a flight of five led by Major George Bailey marked 542's initial departure from Vietnam. Lt.Col. Smith on 31 January led the last five "Tigers" out of DaNang, marking the end of 542's participation in an active combat situation.

From 30 January to 11 February, 542 participated in Key Wallop II - the most monumental TRANSPAC effort ever undertaken by the Marine Corps, involving 35 tactical jet aircraft. The route was DaNang, Cubi Point, Philippines, Guam, Wake Island, Kaneohe, Hawaii, and El Toro.

On 10 February, a division of six aircraft left MCAS Kaneohe, led by Lt.Col. Smith bound for El Toro. An air rendezvous was effected with six KC-130 refueler aircraft 750 miles out of Hawaii. Approximately three hours later Lt.Col. Smith touched down at El Toro, marking 542's initial return to the United States. On 11 February, a division of five aircraft, led by Capt. Ken Crouch, left Hawaii for El Toro, marking the complete return of 542 to CONUS.

Shortly after 542 returned to CONUS they were earmarked for deactivation, with VMFA-323 slated to receive the squadron's fifteen F4-Bs. On 3 March, Lt.Col. Smith relinguished command of 542 to Capt. H. G. Hutchinson who was tasked with supervising the squadron's deactivation. On 20 March 542 entered a cadre status and the "Tigers" were formally deactivated on 30 June.
