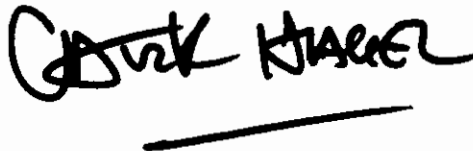
Thank you for contacting my office. I consider constituent inquiries vital to my success as a U.S. Senator and representative of Nebraska.
