I am a free-lance writer, primarily for the South Bend Tribune. On July 25, 1998, Thomas Eugene White of Plymouth, Ind., died at the Roudebush Veterans Medical Center in Indianapolis. He was awarded the Silver Star, the Bronze Star and 3 purple hearts while serving in Vietnam. I am convinced he died of post traumatic stress disorder. He literally drank himself to death. He was 52 years old. While researching this story, I came across your Memorial Plaque Project and intend to make it a focus of the piece.
