This site stands as a testimony of human concern for others. In 1910, the Children's Hospital of Denver was established here in a Victorian mansion. Under President Gerald R. Ford's "Operation Babylift," 600 orphans of the Vietnam War found a haven at Continental Care Center in April 1975, before departing to homes that welcome them all over America.

This plaque commemorates the location of Shirley Peck Barnes' Continental Care Center where 600 Babylift adoptees were cared for "en route" in April, 1975.






