And from their pain relieve them*

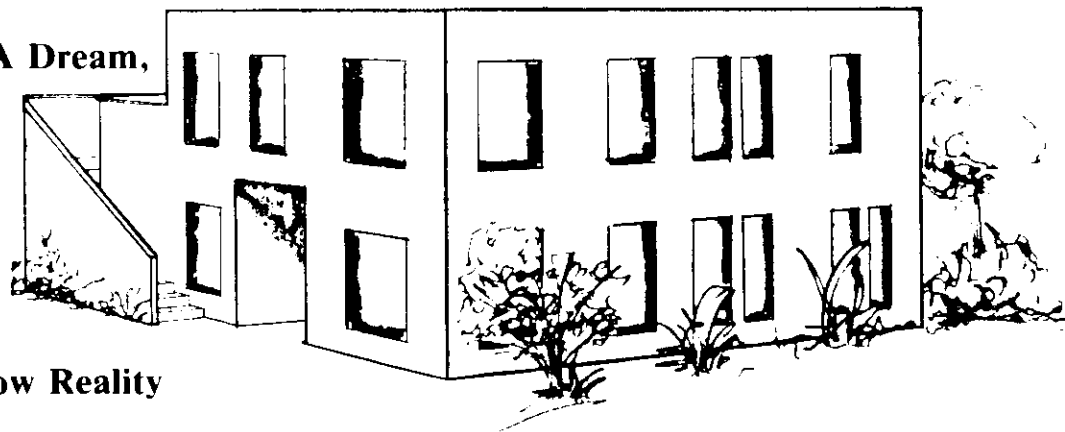
