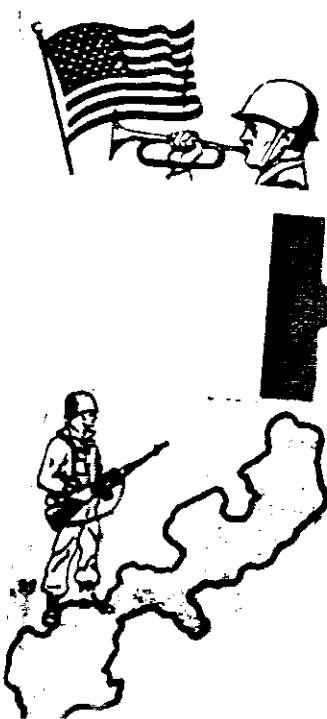

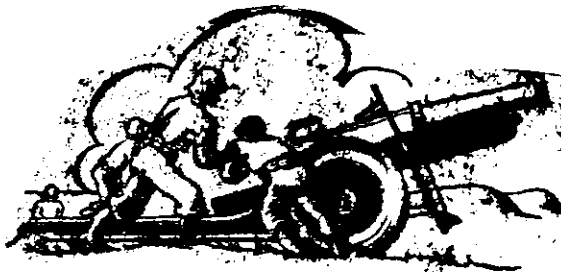

WAR WITHOUT HEROS, by D. Ducan. The one copy I had is now gone. On May 2nd it was given to the mother and father of PFC John Edward Bineman-USMC-Killed in Action-22 Aug. 1968-South Vietnam. John was from Wheeling, Ill. and had been a friend of mine since High School. John had been in "Nam" 7 1/2 months and was in mortars. He died in a mortar attack. I think the book went to the right people. He was the only son of five children. I miss him a little everyday.

This issue seems to be the one for sad news. Staff Sgt. Eugene W. Grygiel-USAFR-Vietnam Vet--"Finders" subscriber-died in a plane explosion during a thunderstorm March 20th, 1982, in McHenry, Ill. They think the plane was hit by lightning. It was not equipped with a black box and authorities are not sure of the reason of the crash. Eugene was not married. He has lived next door to me for the last four years and we spent many hours killing off cold beers and talking about the Nam. He was the crew chief on the KC-135 tanker. 27 other person's also died.

Vietnam reveals cabinet shake-up!! A war wise veteran from the south, Vo Van Kiet, was named deputy prime minster & chairman of the powerful State Planning Commission. He replaces Nguyen Lam, who failed to put a radio, bicycle, and electric light bulb in every home as pledged 2 years ago. (BIG DEAL!!)

"The Vietnam-era veteran now has a national newspaper."

In July of this year, the first issue of the "National Vietnam Veterans Review" rolled off the press. The 28-page tabloid newspaper, published in Fayetteville, North Carolina, is edited by Vietnam War veteran LTC (ret) Chuck Allen, former Commander of the 5th Special Forces Group's famous and highly decorated Project Delta. Allen commanded the top secret Delta for 2 years during the massive North Vietnamese build-up and the TFI Offensive.

Concerning the new publication, Allen states:

"This paper has several major goals. Primarily, it is our intense desire to help accomplish what is most needed right now...Cohesiveness and unity. Our chosen slogan, "Strength in Unity" tells how the job can get done. There is strength in numbers and the larger the unified numbers, the more power to persuade. Numbers means votes, votes mean jobs and with the right people in those jobs the Vietnam veterans will finally receive the rights and services he was asked to fight for!"

"Secondly, communication. We need a sounding board, a carrier of the messages that need to be told. We intend to pull no punches in our reporting, no censorship in our editorial reviews and no one side of the road stand. Fair and equal reporting for all with emphasis on positive attitudes and direction."

The "National Vietnam Veterans Review" is the only newspaper dedicated wholly to the Vietnam-era veteran.

Response to the new newspaper has been overwhelming with hundreds of encouraging letters already received, all expressing the need and timeliness of the paper.

Major news input for the "National Vietnam Veterans Review" will be from the newly formed VVF Radio Network, a private enterprise project launched by the VVF Communications Corporation and the Alexandria, VA based Vietnam Veterans Foundation.

Reporters will be serving the network through its more than 130 stations affiliated and through staff reporters of the newly established, nationally syndicated, VVF press corps.

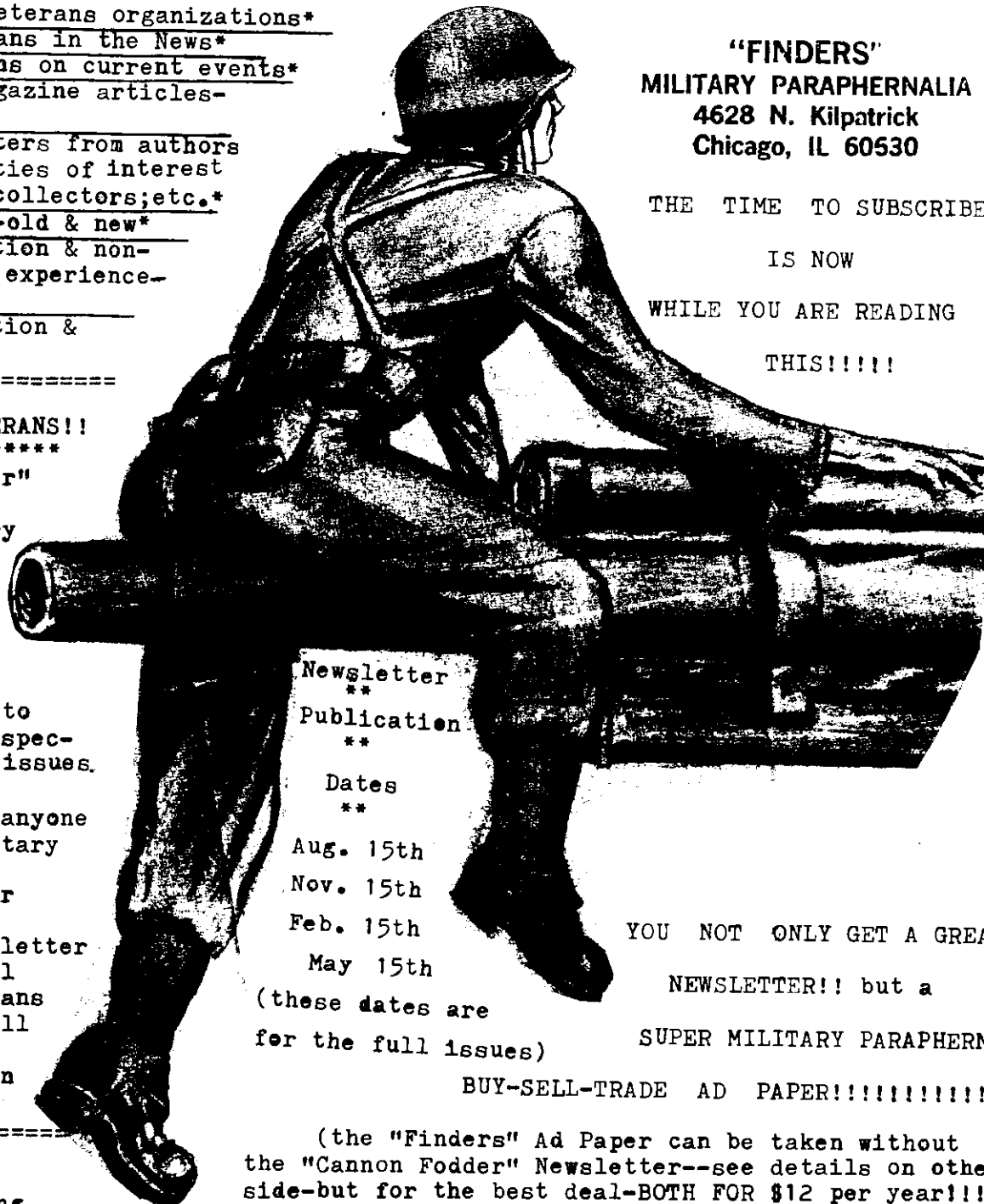

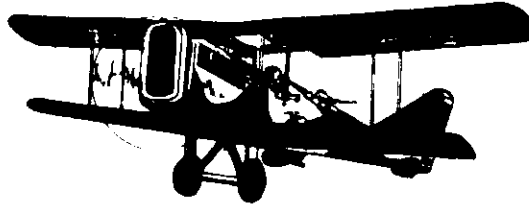

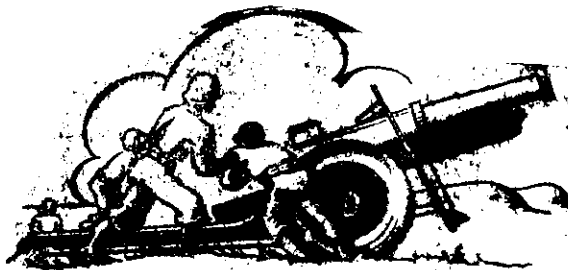
