I hope you are adjusting to the States Slob mentioned ya taking a taxi the way gas an insurance are you are probably right!

I read "Fields of Fire" by Webb last X-Mas it was a gift from my wife made me feel good someones got enough balls to give us back our backbone. It seems to me this country has been in a slide since Nam and also they should have let us win that war.

I've been a carpenter since the wedding doing pretty good I quit the union last month and I'm gonna free-lance cause I'm honest and take pride in what I build.

I had a good job lined up in March soft touch Metallurgy Quality Control but lost it over a hearing problem in one ear. then at Vets hospital they removed a tumor - non malignant

from my knee and I was
laid up a couple of weeks.

They are screening me for
agent orange exposure and
believe me I'm lucky compared
to some of the Vets in there.

I also for some strange reason
ending up talking with a
Vietnamese Doctor a Korean Psychologist
and an American Psychologist it
seemed like a stress relieve
after it was over I mean.

Last Friday they gave me
an ink blot test all this
for a vasectomy. They came to
the last Blotch "whats this they
say?" I told them it was
a 1954 Chevvy Convertible and
then asked them guess who's
driving. The American shrink
almost fell off the table he

was sitting on. Regardless
they discharged me yesterday.
So I gotta be O.K. Now
I'm trying to regroup cause
I was scared.

In the 2/6 Yearbook is a
1st Lt W.M. Tucker under ONTO's he
was Lima's Co. with 3/1 in Nam
Do you have any quick advice
on proper channels to locate
people I'm also trying to hunt
up this corporalsman who's probably
a M.D. now.

I remember one spraying
incident on this operation and
a couple of grunts went into
fits then when we returned
one grunt turned on his own
company with an M-60 we had
to do him in. I'm gonna
list in the DAV book for
help also but don't know

when they will print it.

It seems the V.A. doesn't care about us maybe because there isn't any Viet Vets in there organization. My claim over a hearing condition has been denied twice already & I keep sending in more documentation. The next thing they'll try to convince me I wasn't even over there.

Well Lt Anderson thank you for the time also if your up this way stop in it's close to Niagra Falls and we have plenty of room and your family would be more than welcome.
