Dear Mrs. Williams:


I recently learned from the locator service of Friends of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial that you are the mother of LeRoy Williams, and you would like to hear from veterans who knew your son. I was in charge of the platoon LeRoy was in, which was part of "B" Company, 1st Battalion, 3d Marines, 3d Marine Division. I remember your son as a very cooperative and hard working young man who was always willing to help others. We called him "LC," so I assume his middle initial was "C."

You might be interested to know that those of us who served in Vietnam with "B" Company have been re-establishing contact with each other during the past five years. Thus far we have found over forty veterans who were in the company at some time during the 1967-69 period. If you would like to hear from others who knew your son, it is likely we could come up with some names.
