2. For passenger convenience, it is recommended that luggage be processed the day prior to flights, between 1300 hours and 2200 hours. If this is accomplished, MAC Passenger Service Representative will provide a new reporting time for passengers to return to Terminal.

3. Passengers must acknowledge this Port Call and establish a point of contact with Army ATCO (84-6150) prior to 1530 hours the day prior to flight. Efforts will be made to provide information of flight delays.

4. Personnel will contact nearest medical installation for purpose of obtaining necessary immunizations for this travel.

5. Port Call is void if passport and visa are not in possession of non-US citizen dependents of military or DA civilian personnel.

6. Military personnel must present a completed DA Form 137 (Installation Clearance Record) to the Army ATCO Representative prior to processing for flight.

7. Baggage allowance for military air travel limited to 66 lbs personal effects for service member and each dependent under 12 years of age, and 100 lbs for each adult dependent over 12 years of age unless excess weight is authorized in orders.
