## OUTLINE OF GENERAL CONTENT ORAL SECURITY DEBRIEFING (Part of Security Termination Statement)

1. PURPOSE OF DEBRIEFING. a. To establish that the individual does in fact understand the implications, to national security, and to himself, of the statutes and regulations which he has read.

b. To emphasize to the individual that he was afforded access to classified information solely because of his "need-to-know" in the performance of official duties; that this information was entrusted, as well as officially charged to him; and that his impending retirement, separation, transfer, or reassignment (*as applicable*) in no way lessens his responsibilities and liabilities - for ensuring that the classified knowledge acquired in his most recent position is not divulged in any manner to an unauthorized person or agency.

2. SERIOUS NATURE OF THE SUBJECT MATTER WHICH REQUIRES PROTECTION. Emphasize to the individual that classified information is defined and described in the pertinent statutes and regulations which he has read. As an illustration, cite the fact that **SECRET** defense information is "information or material the unauthorized disclosure of which **COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS DAMAGE TO THE NATION**" (AR 380-5). Where the individual has had access to **TOP SECRET, RESTRICTED DATA, CRYPTOGRAPHIC** information, compartmented information, etc., cite the specific definition(s) and description(s) and emphasize that such material is even more serious in nature.

3. NEED FOR CAUTION AND DISCRETION. a. Emphasize to the individual that the responsibility is *HIS* to specifically establish that a person or agency requesting any classified information is officially authorized (**NEED-TO-KNOW**) that information; that if he is leaving the service (*includes civilian employees*), absolutely no other person or agency is authorized the classified information; that if he is being transferred or reassigned, any classified information known by the individual being debriefed cannot be divulged by that individual unless the new organization and specific person requesting the information has established the need-to-know.

b. Emphasize to the individual that the mere fact that he reads a news article which appears to contain classified information in no way authorizes him to confirm the item. Explain that good "guesses" frequently are reflected by the news media, but bad "guesses" and incorrect information also are included.

c. Caution the individual that history records a number of cases involving unauthorized disclosures in clubs and at social gatherings which have been reported and which resulted in punitive action.

4. ANY TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS IMPOSED. Cite the specific travel restrictions (e. g., as set forth in AR 380-15, AR 380-16 and AR 380-17, for NATO, CENTO, and SEATO information) AR 380-157, for restricted data.

5. SUMMARY. Specifically ask the individual if he understands what he has read and what he is about to sign. Based on his response (*and questions he may raise*) re-emphasize the content of the Security Termination Statement.
