(3) Fire Support: Div Arty displaces two 155mm Howitzers to LZ Siberia, reinforces fires Btry C, 3/82d Arty. Priority of fires to Co D initially and then to TF DELTA (ANNEX C-Fire Support).

b. Co A

(1) Conducts minimum of six ambushes nightly in sector.





1. The Area of Operation

A. Weather

(1) Existing Situation- 3 June 70- Partly cloudy skies with evening rain showers and thunder storms over the mountains. Temperature- Low of 79, and high of 98. Winds-Southeast 5-15 knots. Visibility- 7 miles.

(2) Seven Day Weather Outlook- Thunderstorm activity expected to increase over the mountains. Except for thunderstorms, the weather pattern will consist of partly cloudy skies. Winds- Easterly and southeasterly at 5-15 knots, and maximum temperatures in the middle 90's with minimum temperatures in the upper 70's.

2. Terrain

The terrain south of the Song Thu Bon river is relatively flat and open for 100 to 300 meters south of the river bank. The area consists mainly of well cultivated fields. The terrain both east and west of the Ngon Thu Bon river is flat and sparsely vegetated for 25 to 50 meters on either side. At the present time the Ngon Thu Bon river is fordable at any location where the vegetation along the bank permits. The Song Thu Bon river is fordable at the mouth of the Ngon Thu Bon, also at vic AT 825240. The current of the Song Thu Bon river is swift but other fording spots are possible. As you move away from the river, the land rises steeply consisting of rolling hills and steep ridgelines, most of which are densely vegetated. The ridges are cut by numerous streams running throughout the area. Major trails in the area are the French Road (534), running east to west from Hiep Duc through Phuoc Son to the Ngon Thu Bon river. The bridge at the Ngon Thu Bon River (vic 811199) has been destroyed. There is a major trail running north and south along the banks of the Ngon Thu Bon. There is another

main train running east to west. It runs southwest from My Luu (3) then cutting due west along the southern edge of Hill 143 into Phuoc Son and runs into the French Road (534). The Phuoc Son area is fairly open and thinly vegetated.

3. Enemy Situation

A. During the month of May enemy activity throughout the 4/31 area of operation has increased greatly. The 1st M.F. Regt and parts of the 31st Regt along with supporting units (GK-31, A.A., GK-32 R.R., GK-33 M.M., GK-35 Sapper) all part of the 2nd NVA Division, are believed to be operating in the A.O. As of the 20th May, the 40 Battalion, 1 MF Regt is believed to be located at vic AT 840240. The 60 Battalion, 1 MF Regt at AT 880280, the 90 Battalion, 1 MF Regt at AT 900290, the 7th Battalion, 31 Regt at AT 970285 and the 9 Battalion, 31st Regt vic 875218. During the past week contact with the enemy has been light and sporadic. All enemy elements are believed to be evading to the west and northwest. LZ Siberia has been receiving R.R. fire from vic AT 890230 and 82mm fire from vic AT 879234. Bunkers and fortified positions have been spotted in vic AT 843209 also AT 845206. Several Blue Ghosts gunships FAC have received fire from these areas. Since then arty and airstrikes have been processed in the area and they are believed to be destroyed.

B. The enemy is capable in conducting counter attacks within the area with elements as large as a reinforced Company. Delaying tactics using snipers and small ambushes have been used frequently by the enemy.

C. There have been no reported incidents of mining and booby trapping in the area in the past 60 days. Although the enemy still has this capability.

4. Coordinating Instructions

A. All buildings identified as military structures will be destroyed. Civilian dwellings of the indigenous population will be thoroughly searched, but will not be destroyed except as an unavoidable consequence of combat actions. Food caches over and above the needs of the local population will be reported to this Headquarters and extracted if feasible. Captured or abandoned medical supplies will also be extracted if feasible. They will not be destroyed.

B. Reports

(1) Report all contacts by location of enemy force size of unit, type of weapons, uniform activity, results of contact and direction of withdrawal.

(2) Report all recently used areas and trails.

C. POS's and Detainees

(1) All military age males and females, and suspicious individuals will

be detained and extracted on the first available aircraft.

(2) Detainees and POW's will not be exploited in the field without permission from this Headquarters. Returnees (Hoi Chans) may be exploited.

(3) Interrogate all detainees for information of immediate tactical value.

A. Air Support

1. Three immediate air strikes (Snake and Napalm) will be processed on: AT 805184, 804181, 817179 (031400-031600).
2. Preplans
 - a. Beacon Drop (040200-040400) will be processed on: AT 803184 and 788192.
3. LZ Preparation (040700 Jun 70)
 - a. M-82 High Drag with M-1 Fuze Extender on AT 804183.

B. Artillery Fires

1. A 15 minute LZ preparation will be fired commencing at H-17 to H-2. On call fires have been lanned on routes of approach and possible enemy locations. Preparation and on call targets can be found at Tab A (Target Overlay) and Tab B (Target List). The last round fired in the preparation will be WP quick to signal the end of the preparation.
2. Calls for fire for target locations west of the 80 grid line or south of the 18 grid line will be engaged by a platoon of 3/16 Artillery (155) which will be OPCON to C Btry 3/82 Artillery and located at LZ Siberia.
3. Target locations east of the 80 grid line and north of the 18 grid line will normally be engaged by C Btry, 3/82 Artillery (105). 155's from 3/16 Artillery will be utilized if deemed necessary by the tactical situation.


