In the month of January, Co C made sporadic contact in the 9217 grid with snipers. Personnel evaded to hill 555. There is a known bunker and trench complex in the 9117 grid square. Trails in the area are well traveled. IR missions along the river have found no large concentrations of personnel. There are numerous hootches and civilian personnel in the area. At this time, there are no indications of any large troop concentrations in the hill 555 area. Particular attention should be paid to the possibility of encountering booby traps on the slopes of hill 555 and through Co C A.O.
