SUMMARY: The 1-46 Infantry continued Operation Frederick Hill with light contact resulting in two VC/NVA KIA AND 4 weapons captured. A/1-46 remained at LZ Young and will secure a portion of the convoy route between Tam Ky and Tien Phuoc tomorrow. B/1-46 engaged 3 NVA/VC at 0900 hours near BT 224067 resulting in one enemy KIA. At 1030 hours they uncovered a cache at grid BT 214071 consisting of one MG, 2 shotguns and 1 french rifle. C/1-46 searched the grid BT 21403 with negative results. D/1-46 continued to secure LZ Prof sending one daylight patrol to the west which completed destruction of the tunnel complex north of the Burlington Trail. Recon/1-46 continued to move northeast engaging and killing 1 VC/NVA at 1030 hours, vicinity BT 209088. LRRP Alabama was inserted in the southeastern portion of the AO at 0600 hours this morning and reporting sighting a total of 47 VC/NVA in the grids BT 1301 and BT 1302. All were carrying packs and 32 had weapons.
