CONGRESSMEN VISIT DIVISION

During a visit to a battalion observation post of this Division, Representative Alfred D. Sieminski (D., N.J.) stated that, after seeing combat soldiers at first hand, and observing the conditions which they must endure, he intended to submit a bill to Congress, asking for an increase in pay for front-line soldiers.

Rep. Sieminski said: "Equitable compensation to the men serving in the present four-point-area is small thanks indeed from their country. I feel so strongly on this subject that I shall present a bill to make such a measure into law."

The Representative remarked that such a bill would offer the pay increase as a partial substitute for the lack of benefits extended Korean veterans in relation to those afforded to their brethren of World War II. He pointed out that he was expressing his own opinion, and not that of his colleagues accompanying him on his trip to Korea.

The other Congressmen, members of a sub-committee of the House Appropriations Committee, in Korea to investigate the Army's operations, were: J. Vaughn Cary (D., Va.), Gordon Canfield (R., N.J.), Otto E. Passmore (D., La.), Earl Wilson (R., Ind.); Kenneth Sprangle, Assistant Chief Clerk for the sub-committee was also a member of the party.

The group met for a briefing by staff officers of this Division, and expressed great interest in the winter clothing and its effectiveness.

Rep. Gary, as chairman of the sub-committee, expressed appreciation of the whole party for the clarity and completeness of the briefing. He said that their Korean experience had been very informative, especially that delivered in the Indianhead Division.

After the briefing, they climbed to the observation post where Maj. Gen. Robert N. Young, Division Commander, pointed out the terrain to the front of the lines. Brig. Gen. Haydon L. Boatner, Assistant Division Commander, accompanied the party and explained the tactical situation from the vantage point.

Touring the line with the Congressional party were: Maj. Gen. O.C. Wood, Chief of Staff of Eighth Army and Maj. Gen. W.L. Ryan, IX Corps Commander.

LONELY HEART

Corporal Hugh H. Holmes, a member of the 9th Medical Company is a little worried about his correspondence these days. It seems that the Chicago soldier wrote a letter to a Cleveland, Ohio, newspaper, telling about the need for mail, and his request was forwarded to 33 papers throughout the state.

The result of his small request now has him in a dither about answering his fan mail, all from girls. In five days he received 190 letters, and there has been no letup, so that Holmes is hard-pressed to find the time to acknowledge all of them.

THAI PAPER

The Thailand Battalion recently started publishing its own newspaper for its personnel now fighting with a UN infantry regiment. The Thai paper, named "Battlefield News," is published weekly and contains about 10 pages.

Right now, the newspaper is published only in the Thai language, but according to 2d Lt. Swadi, the Public Information Officer in charge of the publication, part of the news will soon be published in English. Since the Battlefield News is of interest primarily to the Thais, it is written for them, but other members of the Regiment have expressed a desire to learn about this foreign country.

At present, the Thailand PIO receives news of home from Bangkok, through the US Information Service, which transmits it to the battalion in Korea in the English language. Here it is translated into the Thai tongue.

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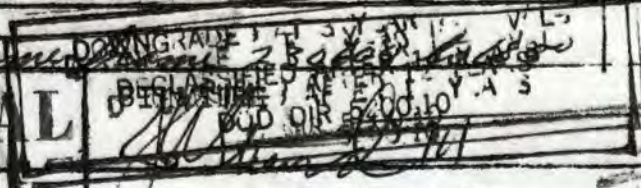

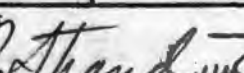
