SYSTEM! REQUESTED BEST WAY TO GET THIS INFO TO THEM - TELEPHONE, FACE-TO-
FACE, WHAT? - SHE DIDN'T KNOW. BUT THERE'S HOPE, SHE STATED THEY'RE
