L.Z. Bayonet F.B. and L.Z. Professional F.B.

After refresher course in fire direction control in June he was  
reassigned FDC ( fire direction control) at a fire base with 2 cannons  
and 20 men called a jump battery because they were able to be ferried by  
helicopter. August then was 3<sup>rd</sup> of 82 Artillery and used L.Z. West F.B.  
, L.Z. Mary Ann F.B. ,and L.Z. Hawk Hill F.B.
