Well here I am again. Went out to Archives II today to get the information (some of it anyway) I misplaced the other day. While there the archivist helping me ~~showed~~ showed me a 3-ring binder with the title USARMY VIETNAM - ORDER OF BATTLE which contains brief histories, dates and places of units during war - so that's what I've enclosed.

Last time I thought I had found the "missing" BN of the 196th but alas I really hadn't - thought it was 1st BN, 46th INF but according to page 88 attached units the 1/46 was assigned to 196th from AUG '71 to JUN '72 thus it couldn't be the "missing" BN and further the 1st BN 6th INF was only assigned during NOV '71. So it appears there wasn't a "missing" BN after all - thus I can drop any further investigations of those two BN's. AFTER READING PAGES 1 (see page 32) I'll have to revise my findings. AS IT STANDS 4/6 was.

However another mystery seemed to arise when I read the blurb about the 1st BN, 14th ARTY and I saw where they were part of the 198th INF, later part of the AMERICAL division but no dates so assume ~~that~~ the AMERICAL assignment occurred prior to your arrival.

My return address label shows that I was a member of ~~the~~ 23rd INF (Regt) in Korea and wonder of wonders I found that the 4th BN (we only had 3 BN's but had French BN attached to 23rd Regt.) 23rd INF (Mechanized) was part of the 25th INF DIVN in Vietnam. This I hadn't known - and to top that off, they had been attached to 172nd INF BDE in ALASKA prior to they're having gone to Vietnam. I'll have to pass that on to my buddies from the "old" 23rd.

I might have mentioned this before but the ^{regiments &} divisions in Korea produced a Narrative Report each month giving a summary of events during that month - some reached 38-40 double spaced, legal sized pages depending on that month's activities. Unfortunately, in 1962 the Army changed reporting requirements and the narrative reports were dropped - all this according to the archivist I spoke with. So the closest we can come to these reports are the Daily Journals of S-2, S-3 etc - I sent you some covering 9-10 days in Sep '70 ^{for one of the BN's.} Sorry I mis-spoke about these narratives, when we talked at Mother / Pops place last month.

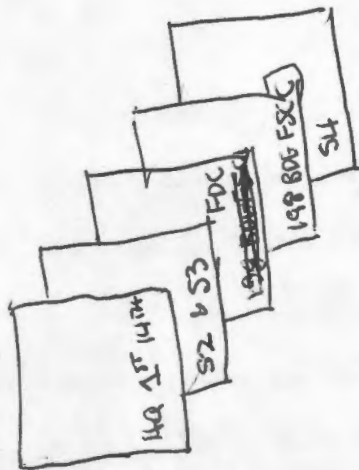
