REPORT: After Action Report-Cyn 300 22

1. DATE AND COMPOSITION OF PATROL: 15 GRP, 01 DTR, 02 USF (Cpt. WING, Sgt. DEEG)
2. MISSION OF PATROL: Conduct recon and ambush via ZC: 150110
3. TIME OF DEPARTURE/TIME OF RETURN: 240600-271330 Mar 67
4. DETAILS OF PATROL:
 - a. Patrol Route: See Annex A.
 - b. Terrain: Streams, trails, heavy jungle growth
 - c. Obstacles: NONE
 - d. Mines and booby traps: NONE
 - e. Actions upon encounter w/enemy: En were moving westerly along trail. One VC in lead, 2 VC approx 15 m to rear. When they approached ambush GRP began to fire killing one VC and causing the other two to flee. The two VC who fled were pursued a short distance and a heavy volume of fire was placed on suspected hiding positions.
5. ANALYSIS INFORMATION:
 - a. Location: En was ambushed on trail at ZC: 150114
 - b. Strength: 3
 - c. Composition: URM
 - d. Activity: Moving west along trail
 - e. Equipment: Dead VC had K-50 SIG, 2 Chinese hand grenades, one ration of rice and meat. 2 VC who fled were armed w/M-36 carbines
 - f. Uniform: Dead VC in Khaki clothing, other 2 in black pajamas
6. CONTACT WITH ENEMY:
 - a. Friendly casualties: NONE
 - b. Enemy KIA and 1
 - c. Enemy WIA and URM
 - d. Enemy captured: NONE
 - e. Equipment captured: 1 K-50 SIG, 2 magazines for K-50, 2 hand grenades
7. CONCLUSIONS: VC appear to be occupying an CP at ZC: 130105 daily. Trail running between Khan-Duc and point of contact provided 2 sets of foot prints approx. 1 day old. Direction of travel-east. Possibly an early warning system. VC who was killed appeared to have been in excellent health and physical condition. His ration consisted of approx. 25 g. rice, 25 g. ground meat, and 1 fish.
8. RECOMMENDATIONS: Recommend an airstrike be called in on village at ZC: 200148. Recommend airino reaction force be sent in to clear village. Recommend another patrol of approx. 40 men be sent into same area and ambush along the same trail, only further east.
