

5750PART IINARRATIVE SUMMARY

Ninth Engineer Battalion under the command of Lieutenant Colonel J. P. KHAYMAK departed Danang RVN 24 August 1970 aboard the LPD 10 (USS JUNEAU), arrived US Naval Shipyard Long Beach California 11 September 1970. Arrived and joined the 5th Marine Amphibious Brigade on the 11th of September. Immediately operations began for deactivation of this Battalion. On 6 October 1970 the battalion became OPCON and ADCON to 7th Engineer Battalion. On 30 October 1970 the Ninth Engineer Battalion was deactivated and it's colors retired.

PART IIISEQUENTIAL LISTING OF SIGNIFICANT EVENTS

On 12 September 1970 Company C, 9th Engineer Battalion, under the command of 1st Lt W. W. SHOPE, rejoined this battalion, leaving the battalion minus Company A, none accounting unit to this command, presently stationed in Hawaii attached to Camp Smith.

No significant events to follow except actual deactivation on 30 October 1970.
