First platoon moved from grid AS 891 992 to grid AS 895 992. ~~Second~~ ^{Third} platoon moved from grid AS 891 992 to grid AS 900 992. B Co. remained on LZ Mary Ann to secure the firebase. First platoon, second squad conducted a reconnaissance mission moving from grid AS 965 992 to an NDP at ^{grid} AS 956 993. Second platoon, second squad also conducted a reconnaissance mission moving from grid AT 947 008 to an NDP at grid AS 960 999. C Co. conducted a search and clear mission moving from their location at grid AS 902 980 to ^{an NDP at} grid AS 908 982. 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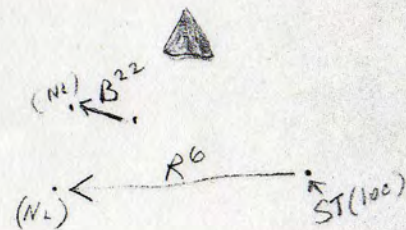
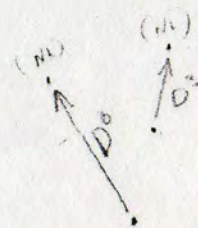
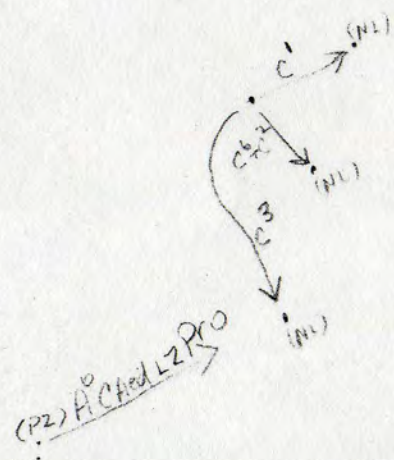
