			SUMMARY: 1-46 continued defense of SECTOR III, Bunker Numbers 1 thru 9. Numerous sightings of VC were observed throughout the hours of darkness. Minimum distance of sightings was approx 150 meters to maximum of 300 meters from front of bunkers. Two suspected VC were taken under small arms fire. Negative confirmed contact. Illumination was put up upon request in areas where movement was suspected or observed. A total of 61 ILL rds were fired during the hours of darkness. Daylight hours brought routine preparation of battalion defense. A party of four Vietnamese were observed moving south at coord BS 845383. One male was wearing web gear and carrying a large bundle. All were wearing black PJ's. They were taken under small arms fire. All broke and ran into the wood line. Visual contact was lost. Negative confirmed contact. A Vietnamese woman was wounded by sniper fire at the machine gun range at approx 1055 hrs. Bn Surgeon, who was at that location, administered first aid and called a Dustoff. Firing was held up during this period. Preparations were completed for Co B to establish a night ambush from 281830 Oct to 290600 Oct and conduct a search, clear, and destroy operation. Lift off time of airlift portion of the operation will be at 290900 Oct 67. Ambush patrol departed base camp at 1730 hrs for selected location. During the course of routine operations one signal lineman received sniper fire from the wood line to the front of bunker #4. Remaining personnel in the battalion base continued to improve defense positions throughout the perimeter.
