

c. B 1-52 (-) conducts detail search vic Lac Son (1) BS 684915. On order moves southeast to blocking positions vic BS 718897, BS 719893. Continue movement into An Thinh (1) BS 725895 conducting detail search. On order conduct further operations.

d. Coordinating Instructions

- (1) Rigid control of all fires by Bn Cmdr.
- (2) Musket controlled by C & C ship.
- (3) Artillery fires cleared by all maneuver elements prior to employment.
- (4) Close liaison and coordination will be conducted prior to operation by 1-52 Inf and 1-14 Arty.
