1. (C) DAILY OPERATIONAL SITREP.

A. NIGHT ACTIVITIES RESULTS: At 0020 E-1 element while on a raiding party at BT446028 heard noises coming from a hut, the element encircled the hut. At this time approx 7 to 12 VC opened up with S/A fire from the hut. Results: 5 WHA (US) (E). 3 VC KIA (BC). Dust Off was completed at 0030. All other patrols returned to company and platoon bases by 150800. Negative results.

B. DAY ACTIVITIES: Co A: Co A secured Hill 54, BT396145 and continued to man and improve bunker placements. One platoon conducted road clearing operation. Moving by truck from Hill 54 and by truck to BT348196. Then moving to BT342188, then to BT342196 and back to pick up site. Negative results.

1. (C) DAILY OPERATIONAL SITREP.

A. NIGHT ACTIVITIES RESULTS: All patrols returned to company and platoon bases by 230800 hours. Negative results.

B. DAY ACTIVITIES: Co A: Co A (-) established NDP, BT471012. At 1645 while setting up for the night one platoon Co A received sniper fire. Fire was returned. Results: 1 US WHA (E). Contact was broken upon the time friendly fire was initiated. Co A continued S&D and conducted saturation patrols vic, NDP. At 1307 a VC Base camp was found ranging from BT470006 to BT471004. Camp was abandoned. Sleeping quarters were found. Camp was cut out with machetes. No equipment was found. Negative contact. Operation continues at time of report.

Co B: Co B (-) established NDP, BT423037. Co B continued S&D operation in assigned AO. At 1045 Co B received heavy sniper and automatic weapons fire at BT423038. Gunships were requested and arrived on station 1155 hours. At 1230 hours air strike was requested (there were a total of 4 air strikes). Results not known at time of report. Operation continues.

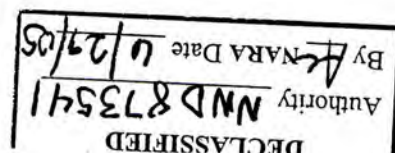
