



From early February to the beginning of July 1969, the men of the 4th Battalion, 21st Infantry constructed numerous forward fire support bases and conducted combat operations in the area surrounding those bases. They also took part in the Americical Division's "Operation Iron Mountain". During that time the Battalion was very successful in thwarting the 2nd NVA Regiment's intention to launch attacks on nearby populated villages along the coastal plains.

On 3 July 1969, the "Gimlets" were deployed to FSB Debbie, located south of Duc Pho, in the Americical Division's southernmost area of operations. On 16 September 1969, LTC George R. Hovey Johnson assumed command of the "Gimlets". Their primary mission at this time was the responsibility for the security of Highway 1 and local pacification. Company D assumed the role as pacification company of the 4th Battalion, 21st Infantry. The dual mission proved to be highly successful in reducing enemy ambushes along Highway 1 and establishing an enviable record of cooperation with Vietnamese military forces and civilians. A systematic three stage program designed for working with the Vietnamese Regional Forces (RF) was implemented. The battalion established a policy to brief all RF Commanders on planned American operations. In the second stage of the program, joint operations with entire RF units were undertaken. In the third stage, the Battalion participated in operations planned entirely by the RF Commanders. This program of military cooperation reaped numerous benefits for the Gimlets as well as for the RF units.


