OPERATION ORDER

Reno Reunion, June 24 - 27, 2004

SITUATION:

A large enemy force identified as the "One Armed Bandit Division" has massed in the vicinity of the **NUGGET HOTEL (Ph. 800 648-1177 / 1100 Nugget Ave)** Sparks, Nevada often referred to on maps as Reno. Reliable intelligence sources confirm this main force unit has direct support fires from both a "Food Brigade" and a "Drink Regiment" in a heavily fortified urban area.

Weather during this operation is expected to be clear, sunny with highs in the upper seventies to mid-eighties and lows in the fifties. No rain is expected.

Friendly support can be expected from other units of the Americal Division who will be operating in close proximity. However some units are reported to be in disarray and may not be able to respond in a timely manner if we are heavily engaged. Movement into Reno by air assault and ground assault teams is expected to be unopposed.

Artillery Support, Chaplain and Medics will be with Alpha Company at all times during this Operation.

MISSION:

To attack, seize and hold the Nugget Hotel in Sparks, NV from 1200 Hours June 23 until 0600 June 28; or until relieved.

EXECUTION:

Advanced party will arrive at 1200 June 23 and secure the LZ. Main party will be CAed in lifts of 1, 2 and 3 packs and take up stations around the perimeter known as the **Registration & Hospitality Room**, "Papa Oscar" **Southern Pacific C**. Perimeter is 790 square feet with pre-positioned fighting locations (tables & chairs). All arriving units will check in with the advanced party for their assignment (**register**).

Once the entire unit is on the ground, rifle platoon will form **Snakes** move out, locate and fix enemy forces. Mortar Section will secure supply routes to and from the stores area. **LPs** and **OPs** will be set-up to give early warning to the main perimeter.

At **1800 (6 PM) 25 June** all elements will rally in the **Rose B** room to conduct the largest Company sized operation since **1971 (Alpha Company Banquet)**. A **"HOT"** will be served and a liquor ration will be available at a **cash bar**. Review of past operations and picture taking will take place immediately following the hot meal. Uniform will be **"Class B"** (dressy casual, business casual - shirt and trousers.) However those just coming off patrol may wear fatigues.

Organizational plans for future operations by Alpha Company 1st Battalion 20th Infantry will be held on Saturday, June 26. Time and place will be announced at the hot meal.

ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS:

Rations for the main perimeter will be secured by foraging parties. All liquor rations must be in the form of bottles (no cans). Convoys will need to plan on an approximately 2-mile trip to supply depots.

No weapons or munitions will be needed, but **bring pictures, souvenirs and CDs or cassettes with your favorite tunes from your time in Duc Pho to share with your buddies**

Uniform of the Day as issued at home prior to embarkation will be in effect at all times. **Alpha Company shirts and hats will be issued at registration for authorized personnel.**

No prisoners will be taken. Medics will care for staggering wounded only.
