<p>NOTE: DUE TO A CAMERA MALFUNCTION, I WAS UNABLE TO FILM A COMPLETE STORY-LINE OF THIS OPERATION.</p> <p>SUMMARY</p> <p>On 29-FEB-68, elements of "C" Co 2nd Bn, 27th Inf, 25th Inf Div, and the 2nd Bn, 23rd Inf(MECH), 25th Inf Div, took part in Operation "Tran Hung Doa", in Binh Duong Province, approx 13Km Northwest of Saigon and 8Km East of their Base Camp in Cu Chi.</p> <p>Operation "Tran Hung Doa" is a Division size Search and Destroy Operation designed to engage the enemy and eliminate suspected enemy mortar and rocket positions which have been endangering Tan Son Nhut Airbase and Saigon during the first weeks of February, 1968.</p> <p>The Units moved into a suspected enemy position and "reconed by fire", during which time they received automatic, small arms and rocket propelled grenade fire from the enemy. After approx a three-hour battle, the Units penetrated the enemy positions, losing one M-113 Armored Personnel Carrier (APC) and several casualties.</p> <p>ROLL ONE (#1)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> LS - UH-1D Helicopters, coming into pick-up area. LS - UH-1D Helicopters, lifting off ground. LS - UH-1D Helicopters, in flight. LS - Same as above. LS - Men dismount from UH-1D Helicopters and move to jungle brush for cover. LS - Man in jungle brush. LS - Men begin to move into a suspected enemy position.
