<p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>SUMMARY</u></b></p> <p>On 17 April 68, at the Royal Thai Army (RTA) Training Facility, near Kanchanaburi, approx 150 kilometers west of Bangkok, Thailand, the Logistical Support of the Royal Thai Army Volunteer Force (RTAVF) was in full swing. The RTAVF was deployed to the facility on 15 April 68 where the final three phases of the training will take place.</p> <p>The 305th Supply and Service Company (S&amp;S Co.) of the 558th S&amp;S Battalion, 9th Logistical Command is providing a large part of the overall support of the RTAVF.</p> <p>The material is shipped in locked comex containers from Sattahip (the closest deep water port to the Training Facility) by Equipment Transportation Organization (ETO) truck to the facility.</p> <p>The 305th S&amp;S Co. has the job of receiving, storing and arranging for transportation and establishing accountability of all equipment issued to the RTAVF. Another function of the 305th S&amp;S Co. is the issuance of all wheeled vehicles to be used in the training of the RTAVF.</p> <p>A water purification plant, which provides portable water for the entire facility, with a total output of 6800 gallons per hour, is maintained at the facility.</p> <p>A Petroleum Oil Lubrication (POL) dump which supplies the fuel for the facility, is also maintained.</p> <p><b><u>NOTE: "NOT FOR PUBLIC RELEASE UNLESS CLEARED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE".</u></b></p>
