SUMMARY

On ²⁷April 1968, General Harold K. Johnson, Chief of Staff of the U.S. Army, visited and inspected the Royal Thai Army (RTA) Training Facility located near Kanchanaburi, approx 150km west of Bangkok, Thailand.

The facility was built by the U.S. Army and Naval- Officer In Charge of Construction (OICC) civilian contract workers and will be used for the training of the Royal Thai Army Volunteer Force (RTAVF).

General Johnson, accompanied by MG Hal D. McCann, Commander of Military Assistance Command-Thailand (MACTHAI)/ Joint U.S. Military Advisory Group (JUSMAG) and BG Edwin F. Black, Commander U.S. Army Support/Thailand (USAR SUP/THAI), briefly toured the facility, and later presented Army Commendation Medals to ten of the U.S. Army personnel who helped construct the facility.

Just prior to his departure, General Johnson addressed the troops of the Engineer Units which constructed the facility, for their outstanding work in accomplishing their task in a brief period of time.
