<p style="text-align: center;"><u>SUMMARY</u></p> <p>On 27-28 APR 1968, in the vicinity of Phuket, (Island Province), approx 1000 km southwest of Bangkok, on the Malay Peninsula, a Mitrapab Jump was performed.</p> <p>Mitrapab, (a Thai word meaning friendship), is a combined Thai and US civic action program composed of the US Army (USA), US Air Force (USAF), Royal Thai Army (RTA), Royal Thai Air Force (RTAF), Royal Thai Police (RTP), and civilian businessmen.</p> <p>The main event on the program is the Jump Show. The Jump Show consists of static-line and free-fall sky-diving performances. The aircrafts being utilized for the jumps are RTAF C-123 and a USAF C-7A (Caribou). The first jumpers are, one Thai Officer and one US Officer, each carrying the others National Flag. The next jumpers are members of the Soccer Ball team from the RTA Special Warfare Center, who are dressed in their Soccer uniforms and shoes. After the landing they play a match against the local Soccer Champions. The third group of jumpers is composed of female sky-divers who jump from 7000 to 10,000 feet altitude. Finally the male acrobatic sky-divers at 10,000 to 15,000 feet and delay opening their parachutes, performing a variety of maneuvers while falling. After all parachutists are down safely, there is a formation and the Province Governor gives each jumper a small gift.</p> <p>The Motto is: "Raising Funds for Raising Schools". A school is built with the funds reaped from the tickets, purchased by the spectators attending the show.
