ABBOTT (Lansing, Illinois), Motion Picture Photographer, US Army Photographic Detachment, Pacific (6442), Ft. Shafter, Hawaii. The Purple Heart was presented to SP/5 ABBOTT at the US Military Assistance Command Headquarters in Bangkok, Thailand, (MACTHAI) by MG Hal D. MCGOWN, CG, US Military Advisory Group (JUSAG), US Military Assistance Command, Thailand (MACTHAI), while SP/5 ABBOTT was on a TIE Photographic assignment from Ft. Shafter, Hawaii. SP/5 ABBOTT received the Purple Heart award for a shrapnel wound he received from enemy rocket and mortar rounds fired upon the 1st Infantry Division's base camp in Lai Kye, South Vietnam, while SP/5 ABBOTT was on another TIE Photographic Assignment from Ft.
