SUMMARY

ON 16-17 MAY 1968, THE LAST OF THE AIRCRAFT THAT WAS ASSEMBLED AT KORAT, (APPROX 215km NORTH OF BANGKOK) WERE FLOWN TO THE ROYAL THAI ARMY TRAINING FACILITY AT KANCHANABURI, (APPROX 150km WEST OF BANGKOK).

THE AIRCRAFT WILL BE UTILIZED BY THE ROYAL THAI ARMY LIGHT AVIATION COMPANY (LT. AVN. CO.) FOR TRAINING AND TO ASSIST IN THE SUPPORT OF THE ROYAL THAI ARMY VOLUNTEER FORCE (RTAVF) WHICH WILL BE DEPLOYED TO THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH VIETNAM IN THE NEAR FUTURE.

AT THE PRESENT TIME THE RTA LT. AVN. CO. CONSISTS OF FOUR (4) OH-13 HELICOPTERS AND FOUR (4) O-1 BIRD DOGS. AFTER THE LAST AIRCRAFT, THREE (3) OF THE O-1 BIRD DOGS AND TWO (2) OF THE OH-13 HELICOPTERS, ARRIVED AT THE RTA TRAINING FACILITY, THEY FLEW OVER THE AIRFIELD IN FORMATION AND THEN LANDED. MAJ ARTHUR D. BILLS (CHOES, N.Y.), CHIEF US ARMY AVIATION ADVISOR TO THE RTA, GREETED MAJ JENHAT JENKRABUANHAT THE COMMANDING OFFICER OF THE LT. AVN. CO.. BOTH MAJORS INSPECTED AND DISCUSSED THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE NEWLY ARRIVED AIRCRAFT.

THE RTA LT. AVN. CO. INCLUDES FULLY QUALIFIED MAINTENANCE CREWS FOR BOTH THE FIXED AND ROTARY WINGED AIRCRAFT.
