<p style="text-align: center;"><u>SUMMARY</u></p> <p>On 24 MAY 1968, at Kanchanaburi, approx 150km West of Bangkok, The Royal Thai Army Volunteer Force (RTAVF) began the Army Training Test (ATT).</p> <p>They moved out to the Training Test area, approx 45km East of the Training Facility, by vehicle convoy. Upon arrival at the assembly area, the men set up a defense position and prepared maps on Army Tactics to take place that day.</p> <p>Once the defense position was prepared an order was given for individual companies to begin Reconnaissance Patrols.</p>
