SUMMARY					
<p>On 10 Jun 1968, two U.S. Army soldiers, SP/4 Ronald J. LEHRMAN (Granite, Okla.), and PFC Jerry C. TESTER (Boone, N.C.), detained in Cambodia last month were freed.</p> <p>The release of SP/4 LEHRMAN and PFC TESTER, was ordered by Head of State Prince Norodom Sihanouk who said it was a mark of respect for the late Senator Robert Kennedy. The two men were handed over to the Australian Ambassador at the foreign ministry at Phnom Penh, Cambodia. The two men and eight Filipinos were held on the 20 May 1968, after being intercepted on the Cambodian River aboard a tug. The Filipinos were released on Saturday. Prince Sihanouk had earlier rejected an American request for the release of the men saying that foreigners found in Cambodian territorial waters had to be judged by Cambodian law. Prince Sihanouk announced the unconditional release of the Americans in a telegram of condolence to Mrs Ethel Kennedy.</p>
