SUMMARY

19 JUNE 1968, Elements of the 539th Engineer Detachment, 1st Sp Forces Group, 1st Sp Forces, are presently assigned on a Temporary Duty (TDY) assignment to U.S.O.N. at the North East Technical Institute (NETI) at Korat, Thailand (approx 252km NE of Bangkok).

The Institute participates in the training of surveying, foundry works, automotive mechanics, welding, wood, print, metal and machine shops and other various technical skills.

Located within the Institute, men of the 539th Eng Det, are instructing students of the Accelerated Rural Development (ARD) Program, in theory, operation and maintenance of engineer heavy equipment.

ARD students are volunteers from many of the Changwads (Provinces) in Northern sections of Thailand. The students are required, under contract, to work for the Thai Government for a period of one (1) year, upon completion of their training.

When their training is completed at NETI, they return to their Changwad with equipment, to construct and maintain roads, that will connect villages within their Changwad. The construction of these roads broadens the local farmers sale of crops and brings the villagers together for better relationships.
