SOUND PROVIDED, SYNC ONLY.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>SUMMARY</u></p> <p>On 16-20 Dec 1968, elements of the 176th and 264th Medical Detachments (Med Det), in Cam Ranh bay, RVN. (approx 305kms NNE of Saigon), continued their mission to provide veterinary food inspections service as required, to protect the health of the United States (US) Armed Forces and the economic interests, of the US Government; so far as these factors relate to the procurement, receipt, storage, issue and shipment of subsistence. In addition, they provide assistance to the Surgeon at all levels of command in discharging the later responsibilities for zoonosis control sanitation associated with subsistence and Veterinary Preventative Medicine.</p> <p>Another mission, of the 176th Med Det, is the conducting of a Civic Action Program, which consist of visiting farms in the rural area and vaccinating indigenous livestock against disease.</p> <p>The 175th Med Det, in DaNang, RVN (approx 575kms NNE of Saigon), provides veterinary food inspections service, daily, for the US Navy, at the Naval Supply Activity (NSA).</p> <p>In addition, the 175th Med Det, provides veterinary services to the US Navy K-9 (Gentry Dogs), through the operation of sick call and administraiing monthly physical examinations to the dogs.</p> <p>(*SP/5 ROBERT G.
