<b>SUMMARY</b>					
<p>On 27-29 Dec 1968, elements of the 760th Medical Detachment (Veterinary); Med Det (Vet); in Qui Nhon, RVN (approx 430kms NNE of Saigon), with sub-stations in Da Lat (approx 225kms NNE of Saigon), and Pleiku (approx 390 kms NNE of Saigon), continued their mission to provide veterinary food inspections service as required, to protect the health of the United States (US) Armed Forces and the economic interests of the US Government, in the Republic of Vietnam; so far as these factors relate to the procurement, receipt, storage, issue and shipment of subsistence.</p> <p>In addition, they provide assistance to the Surgeon at all levels of command in discharging the later responsibilities for zoonosis control sanitation, associated with subsistence and Veterinary Preventative Medicine.</p> <p>The 760th Med Det (Vet), also provides veterinary support to Military Dogs and Mascots, owned by US Government personnel.</p> <p>Another mission of the 760th, is the conducting of Civic Action Programs, which consist of visiting farms and villages in the rural areas and vaccinating indigenous livestock against disease.</p>

LS- SSG Jim L. PENNINGTON (Seattle, Wash), NCOIC-Chief Food Inspector (LEFT) and SP/5 Steve A. THOMPSON (Tacoma, Wash) Food Inspector Specialist, inspect crates of lettuce at the US Army Procurement Agency (USAAPA) in Da Lat. (Most of the produce utilized by US Armed Forces in RVN, are grown in the Da Lat area, inspected, and shipped on US Air Force C-130 aircrafts to given destinations...).

LS- PAN- as M-151 Jeep, driven by SP/4 Wayne L. WAHLMEIER (Clayton, Kansas), MP of the "B" Company, 504th MP Co. Jeep stops and PFC James S. SMELSER (Big Spring, Texas), MP of the "B" Company, 504th MP Co; carries a stray dog, found on a US Military compound, to the Veterinary office.

MLS- PFC SMELSER, carries stray dog into Veterinary office.

CU- Sign, "Vet Office; Pleiku Sub-Station; 760th Vet Detachment"...

MS- CPT Roy A BRAUM (Denison, Kansas), Vet-, leaving office building as PFC SMELSER follows. PAN AND ZOOM TO MLS- as CPT BRAUM walks to kennel facility, and opens a door to one of the kennels. PFC SMELSER places the stray dog in the kennel where the dog is kept until claimed.
