SUMMARY

HONOLULU, Oahu, HAWAII

THERE IS NO PLACE LIKE HOME, OR AT LEAST A GOOD SUBSTITUTE FOR IT. AND HAWAII IS THE MOST POPULAR OF THE R&R AREAS FOR OUR TROOPS IN VIETNAM. IN FACT, SINCE THE HAWAII R&R PROGRAM STARTED ON 3 AUGUST 1966, 53,000 SERVICE PERSONNEL HAVE SELECTED THIS TROPIC ISLE FOR THEIR SEVEN DAYS OF WELL EARNED REST. THE REASONS FOR THE POPULARITY ARE OBVIOUS; IT'S EASIER TO MEET FAMILIES HERE, REDUCED AIR FARES ON COMMERCIAL CARRIERS FROM THE WEST COAST TO HAWAII AND BACK, AND AN IDEAL AND WORLD FAMOUS RECREATION CENTER, AND MORE SIMPLY, HAWAII IS A PART OF THE GOOD OLD U.S.A.

IN THE MONTHS SINCE THE PROGRAM BEGAN, APPROX. 35,000 DEPENDENTS HAVE MADE THE TRIP TO HAWAII. THEY CAME FROM EVERY PART OF THE UNITED STATES. ONE WIFE CAME FROM SPAIN TO MEET HER HUSBAND, ANOTHER FROM COSTA RICA, STILL OTHERS FROM ALASKA AND CANADA.

R&R FLIGHTS FROM VIETNAM TO HAWAII ORIGINATE IN SAIGON, DANANG, AND CAM RANH BAY AND ARRIVE IN HAWAII AT THE RATE OF TWO A DAY, FORTY-FIVE TO FIFTY A MONTH, 150 flights since August of 1966.

FT. DENISON R&R CENTER HAS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF HELPING SECURE LODGING, PROVIDING INFORMATION ABOUT HAWAII, AND HELPING SERVICE PERSONNEL AND DEPENDENTS ENJOY THEIR TIME TOGETHER.
