			<u>SUMMARY</u> On 18-20 JUL 1968, at Hickam Air Force Base (Hick AFB), Honolulu, Hawaii, the Government Presidents, Lyndon B. JOHNSON (USA) and Nguyen Van THIEN (ZVN) met in the Pacific for the third time in three years. President JOHNSON arrived on Air Force One with Secretary of State, Dean RUSK and Senator Daniel K. INOUÉ, of Hawaii. President JOHNSON and his Party were greeted by Secretary of Defense, Clark GIFFORD; ADM U.S. Grant SHARP, Pacific Commander in Chief; Hawaiian Governor John A. HUNN; and Honolulu's Mayor Neal S. BLAISDELL. The group walked to the waiting helicopters, one which airlifted President JOHNSON to the Estate of the late Industrialist, Henry J. KAUER. The Kauer Estate will be the residence of the President while his stay in Hawaii. Almost three hours later, the President returned to Hick AFB to greet President THIEN arriving from Saigon, Vietnam. The two Presidents then witnessed a brief ceremony in their honor and inspected an Inter-Service (IS) Honor Guard. "Our pledge to help your people defeat aggression stands firm against all obstacles and against any deception". With these words President JOHNSON welcomed President THIEN to Hick AFB on the 18 of July 1968, for several days of high level conferences. Briefed and assisted by several of his top aides: Secretary of State, Dean RUSK; Secretary of Defense, Clark GIFFORD; Ambassador to Vietnam, Elsworth BUNKER; Chief of Staff, GEN Earle G. WHEELER and CIA Director, Richard HELMS; President JOHNSON discussed the latest developments in the war in Vietnam with President THIEN. Special consideration, it is believed, was given to the army build up around Saigon, Augmentation of South Vietnamese Troops (ARVN) and the continuing fight against corruption in the South Vietnamese Government. In addition, time was spent discussing the events that led to the Paris Peace Negotiations. To include what was said in the talks followed the talks. Also, Secretary of State, Dean RUSK, briefed the two leaders and gave his evaluation of what was going on in Paris. *****

			<u>SUMMARY.....continued</u> ...in Paris.. The talks between Presidents JOHNSON and THIEU, took place at Camp H.M. SMITH, approx 2900 ft of Honolulu, Headquarters for USAF Lt. Gen. Grant SIMP, Pacific Commander in Chief (CINCPAC). The two Presidents and their aides began meeting early on the morning of the 19th and continued discussions over a "working lunch". Saturday, the 20th, began with a "working breakfast" for the two leaders and the talks went into their second and final day. Finishing early, President JOHNSON arrived at HIK AFB at approx 0915 hrs in the Presidential helicopter and immediately boarded Air Force One for the return flight to Texas. 30..... TWO(2)			THE FIRST PORTION OF THIS ROLL SHOWS THE ARRIVAL OF PRESIDENTS JOHNSON AND HIS PARTY BEING GREETED BY SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, CLARE CLIFFORD; ADMIRAL U.S. GRANT SHARP, PACIFIC COMMANDER IN CHIEF; HAWAIIAN GOVERNOR JOHN A. BURNS; AND HONOLULU'S MAYOR HEAL S. BLAISHELL. PRESIDENT JOHNSON IS SHOWN BOARDING A HELICOPTER TO AIRLIFT HIM TO THE ESTATE OF THE LATE INDUSTRIALIST HENRY J. KAISER.
