			SUMMARY On 1 August, 1968, at approx 1000 hrs, GEN William C. WESTERHOLAND, US Army Chief of Staff, arrived at Sills Field, Schofield Barracks, approx 26 kms North of Honolulu, Hawaii, traveling to Schofield Barracks by OH-23 helicopter, GEN WESTERHOLAND called on MG Roy LASSITER Jr., CG, US Army Hawaii. (Accompanying GEN WESTERHOLAND to Schofield Barracks was LIE Edgar DOLEMAN, US Army Pacific Acting Commander). After their arrival at Sills Field, the two Generals attended a ceremony in honor of the new Chief of Staff (Army) by the 29th Inf Bde Honor Guard and the US Army Pacific Band. As GEN WESTERHOLAND trooped the line of the 29th Inf Bde Honor Guard, he stopped several times to shake hands with some of the men. After the ceremony, GEN WESTERHOLAND attended a command briefing at US Army Hawaii Headquarters and then moved out into the training areas for a first hand look at the 29th Inf Bde training program. After a demonstration at range #10 (East Range), GEN WESTERHOLAND and his party were helicoptered to the Kahuku "B" range for lunch and later observed troops of the 100th Bn, 1st2nd Inf, participating in the Army Training Test (ATT) at company level. Being briefed by the test director at the ATT control center, GEN WESTERHOLAND moved to the defense positions of the 100th Bn's Co "A", and watched defensive phases of the testing. Accompanied by GEN LASSITER, GEN WESTERHOLAND was escorted through the 29th Inf Bde's training operations in the Kahuku ranges, approx 6-8 kms East of Schofield Barracks. Leaving the Kahuku training areas, GEN WESTERHOLAND traveled to Fort Le Russy, Honolulu, Hawaii to prepare for his 1700 hr departure from Hickam AFB where he was seen off by many Military and Civilian dignitaries, including GEN Earl GIBBON, Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, who accompanied GEN WESTERHOLAND on his return trip to Washington.

IN ADDITION, THIS ROLL SHOWS GEN WESTERLAND PROCEEDING TO THE MESS AREA TO HAVE LUNCH BEFORE VIEWING ELEMENTS OF THE 29th INF BDE PARTICIPATING IN THE ARMY TRAINING TEST (ATT). AFTER LUNCH, GEN WESTERLAND WAS ESCORTED TO A BRIEFING TENT AND THEN DRIVEN TO THE TRAINING SITES. <u>ROLL TWO (2)</u> THIS ROLL SHOWS GEN WESTERLAND TALKING WITH A FEW MEN THAT WERE UNDER HIS COMMAND DURING THE KOREAN CONFLICT. GEN WESTERLAND THEN PROCEEDED TO ANOTHER TRAINING SITE TO VIEW MEN OF THE 29TH INF BDE PARTICIPATING IN THE ATT. AFTER COMPLETING HIS TOUR OF THE TRAINING SITES, GEN WESTERLAND BID FAREWELL AND WAS LIFTED BY AN CH-23 HELICOPTER TO FT DEWESY IN HONOLULU, TO PREPARE FOR HIS RETURN TO WASHINGTON.
