THIS STORY COVERAGE IS OF HISTORICAL AND NEWS-WORTHY VALUE... <u>SUMMARY</u> On 3 Apr 69, GEN Charles E. BORNSTEIN III, CINC, United Nations Command (UNC), Commander, US Forces Korea and CG, Eighth US Army Korea, awarded SGT Henry S. DOMBINE Jr. (Atlanta, Ga), Sqd Leader "B" Co, 3d Bn, 23d Inf, 2d Inf Div, the first Combat Infantry Badge (CIB), in Korea since 27 July 1953. The ceremony took place at 23d Inf Hqs, located approx 55km NW of Seoul, Korea. Receiving the CIB, Posthumous, was PFC Calvin L. LINNEY, Medic, Hqs Co, attached to "B" Co, who was "killed in action". Both men were members of a ten man work detail, replacing weather worn Military Identification Line (MIL) markers on 15 Mar 1969, within the MIL zone, when they came under heavy caliber and small arms automatic weapons fire from an undetermined number of North Koreans. The work detail had been previously cleared with the North Koreans at Panmun Jon.
